SMS AUTHENTICATION METHOD

When you first log into UniFI or UniFI 2.0, you will be prompted to set up multi-factor authentication (MFA).

SET-UP TAKES JUST A FEW MINUTES

Step 1

When you click on the UniFI or UniFI 2.0 link, you will be redirected to the portal webpage, where you will be asked to enter your **Username**.

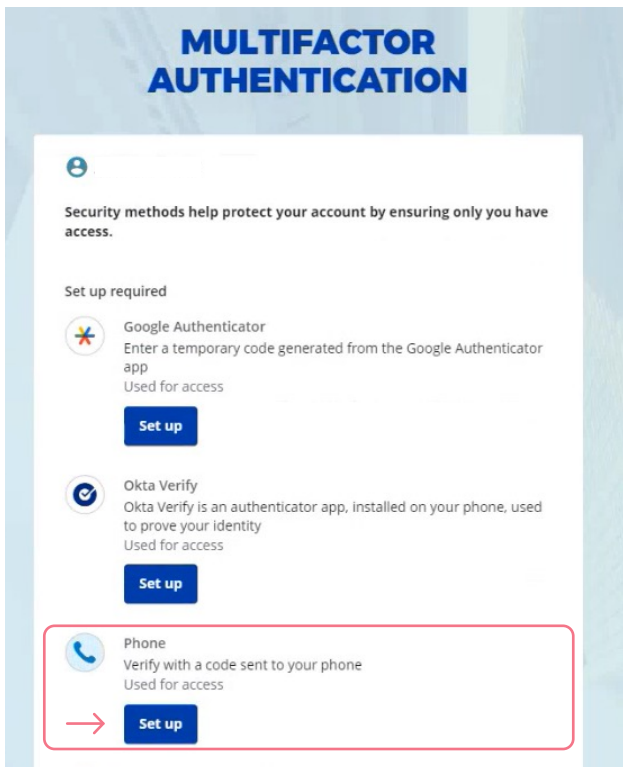
Step 2

Enter your **Password**.

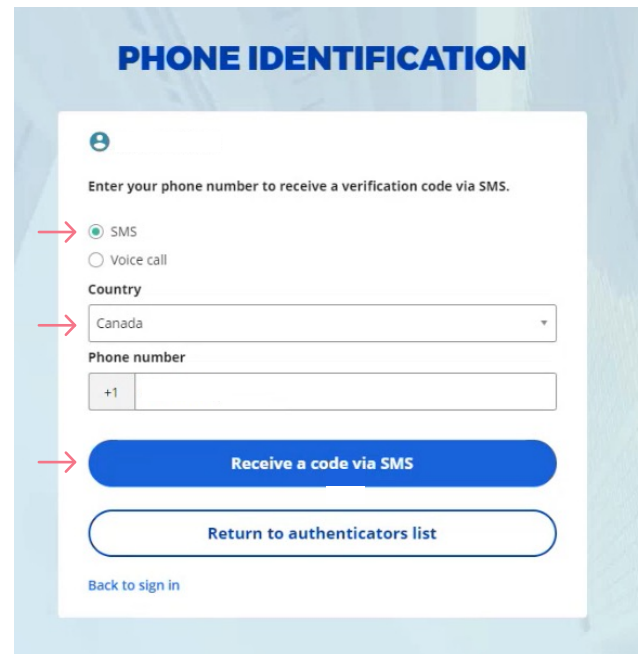
Step 3

Click on the **Set up** button in the Phone Authentication section.




Step 4

Next you will be asked to select the **Country** and enter the **Phone number** where you wish to receive your security code. Then click on **Receive a code via SMS**.



Step 5


Once you have received the unique security code, you will need to **Enter the code** that is given to you and click **Next**.



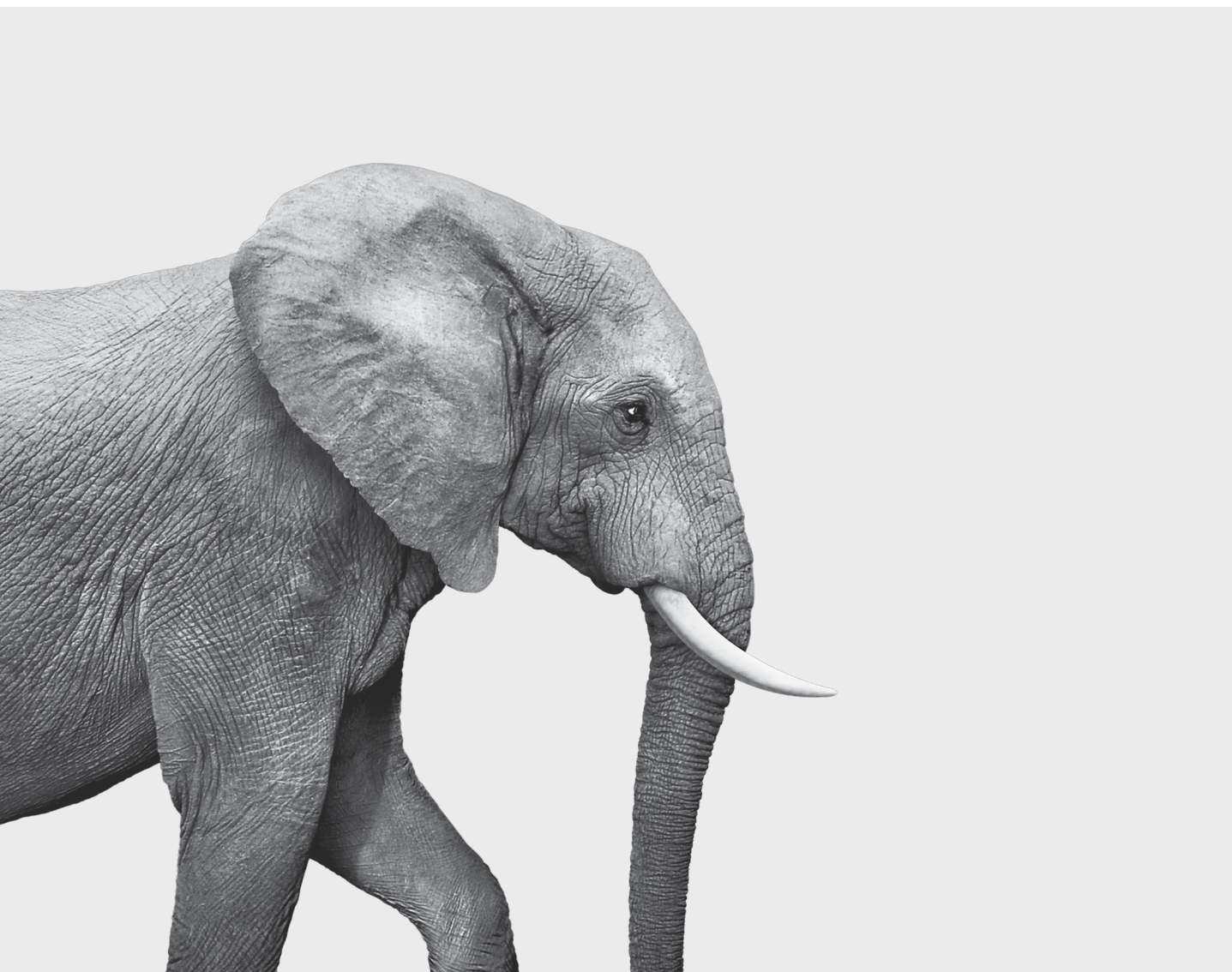
Step 6

You have now completed the SMS Authentication set-up and will be taken back to the configuration page.

You can choose to set up an additional MFA method; or click on **Set up later** to continue to your UniFI or UniFI 2.0 Portal.



Going forward, when you log into the UniFI or UniFI 2.0 Portal, you may be **prompted to provide a unique security code**, which will be sent through SMS (text message).
