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Is the U.S. economy nearing full employment?

World

After having plummeted 14% in July, oil prices rebounded in August, returning to levels above the \$45 mark. This volatility can largely be attributed to seasonal speculation over the level of gasoline inventories in the United States, and not to any major changes in the global picture of supply and demand. However, the oil market could, in the coming months, remain sensitive to the talks regarding a possible production freeze within the Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC), a key topic to be discussed at the committee's next meeting in September.

Oil price (WTI) in U.S. dollars

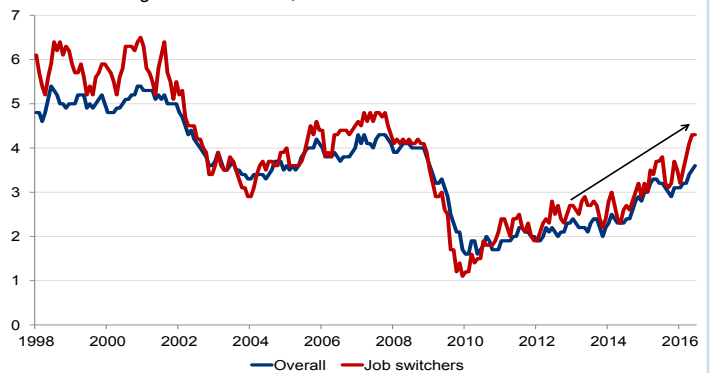


North America

In the United States, the good behaviour of the job market is creating an increasingly rapid growth in wages. According to the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta's Wage Growth Tracker, wages for workers who have changed jobs are growing at a pace of 4.3% on an annual basis, a level not seen since 2007 and which suggests that the economy is approaching full employment. Although it is too early to draw any definite conclusions, a sustained wage push is a factor historically associated with inflationary pressures, and could therefore influence the committee responsible for U.S. monetary policy.

Financial markets

The probability that the U.S. Federal Reserve (Fed) will go ahead with a second rate hike before the end of the year has considerably increased since the Brexit event. Speaking publicly on August 26, Fed Chair Janet Yellen herself stated that the economic environment had improved in the last few months, making it more favourable to a tightening of monetary policy. Of course, the decision will depend on the quality of the economic data, with employment at the top of the list.
