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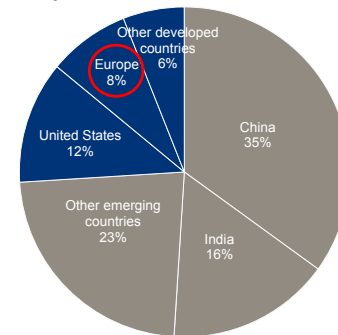
## Brexit: A disruptive event?

### World

The English people created a shockwave by voting 52% against the proposal to remain within the European Union, in the historic referendum held on June 23, 2016. The chances of seeing the United Kingdom enter a recession in the near future are considerable, while the European economy could also suffer repercussions, given the uncertainty present on the political front and the potential for business investment to decline. However, the world economic situation is not likely to be too tarnished by this event. Europe's contribution to world economic growth is relatively small (less than 10%), with the emerging countries accounting for more than 70%.

Estimated relative contribution of countries to global GDP growth in 2016

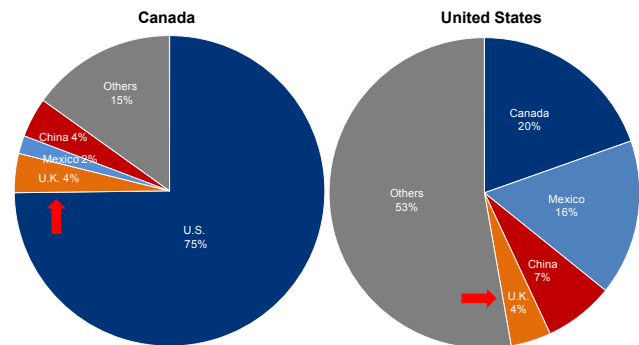


### North America

One of the most significant economic impacts of Brexit will likely be the eventual process of renegotiating trade agreements between the United Kingdom and its many trading partners. However, the economic consequences for Canada and the United States should be modest, given that less than 5% of our exports are destined for the United Kingdom. As well, exactly when this process is triggered will depend on when article 50 of the Treaty of Lisbon is invoked, a step that may only occur in the fall when a new leader for the Conservative Party is chosen.

### Financial markets

Stock markets around the world were surprised and shaken on June 24 by the result of the British referendum. The European index Eurostoxx 50 lost more than 11% in the two days following the vote, something that had not been seen since the Lehman Brothers bankruptcy. Although the financial impacts of Brexit are far from comparable to those of the 2008 financial crisis, the severity of the damage in the European market can be attributed to the complacency of markets in the days leading up to the referendum (the European stock market had returned to positive for the month), despite polls suggesting a very close vote.

rate fluctuations. Moreover, it reports a high current yield as it has the latitude required to invest in bank loans as well as municipal, provincial, corporate and, to a lesser extent, federal bonds.

Foreign securities held in the Fund are covered against currency fluctuations. This type of fund can offer additional protection against future interest rate hikes. However, because of the nature of this type of fund, it carries more risk than a universal bond fund.
