What are my options?

You can purchase this insurance for a single trip or on an annual basis for multiple trips. You can purchase the insurance to protect your entire trip or as a top-up.

Single Trip

A single trip policy covers **one trip only**.

You can choose one of **three options**:

- Single Trip within Canada, which provides coverage within Canada only
- Single Trip worldwide for trips anywhere in the world including the USA

Section 440 of the Act respecting the distribution of financial products and services (chapter D-9.2)

THE ACT RESPECTING THE DISTRIBUTION OF FINANCIAL PRODUCTS AND SERVICES GIVES YOU IMPORTANT RIGHTS.

The Act allows you to rescind an insurance contract, **without penalty**, within 10 days of the date on which it is signed. However, the insurer may grant you a longer period.
