- Ensure that your passport is valid and bear in mind the [processing times](#) to apply for or renew a passport (trip cancellation coverage does not provide protection in the event of an invalid passport).
- Arrive at the airport early (trip cancellation coverage does not provide protection in the event of this kind of late arrival).
- Travel light (trip cancellation coverage provides assistance in the event of the loss or late arrival of your luggage).
- Keep your proof of travel insurance close at hand to avoid any surprises. This is always available online, in your My Client Space and iA Mobile.
- Be aware of government guidelines, warnings, rules and advice, when at home and when abroad, on the subject of travel ([FAQ](#), [Travel advice and warnings by destination](#), [Travel and tourism Canada](#), [Canadian Transportation Agency](#)).
